Our commitments

- Check that everyone we employ has the right to work in the UK.
- Expect the suppliers we buy from, and any labour we engage, to uphold the same standards.
- Be alert to the risk of modern slavery and act on any concern that is raised.
- Encourage anyone, employee or otherwise, to report a concern without fear of reprisal.
- Review this policy at least once a year.

Scope

Our annual turnover is below the threshold at which a statement under section 54 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 is required. This policy sets out our voluntary commitment to the same principles.
